Are your programs or services on site at NYCHA or do residents participate in off-site programming? If off-site, where?

If your programs are on-site, what spaces have you used or do you currently use (i.e. community centers/ RA office/ off-site?) Are these spaces accessible and comfortable for residents? Have there been specific benefits or challenges to accessing these spaces?

Which NYCHA developments does your organization engage? Approximately how many residents participate?

What NYCHA age group(s) do you serve?

What specific programs/ activities / skills are they provided with?

Does your organization conduct targeted outreach to NYCHA developments? How do you incentivize residents to participate in your work/join membership?

How do you engage/operate in the long-term? How do you track and/ or measure your engagement efforts and outcomes?

How do you finance your engagement efforts? i.e. grants? government support?

What have been your more successful initiatives? How was the outreach, response from residents, and follow-up?
